

2025 Sewer and Stormwater Rate Adjustments – Effective 1/1/2025

After careful review of the 2025 Fiscal Year Budget, the Authority Board has approved a moderate sewer rate increase of 3%, or about 5 cents per day for a typical residential user, effective January 1, 2025. This increase will help to offset inflationary increases in operation costs associated with the treatment of more than 1.5 billion gallons of sewage and the processing of 5,000 tons of biosolids annually. The user rate increase will also help fund sustainable capital improvement projects for the benefit of maintaining the level of service provided to our ratepayers.

The DTMA Stormwater Management Program (SMP) fee will increase by \$0.50 per Equivalent Residential Unit (ERU) per month starting in January 2025. The SMP continues to serve the Township's stormwater infrastructure improvement needs and ensure compliance with state and federal regulations. The SMP fee will enable DTMA to address the Township's future stormwater management needs and initiatives while also remaining financially stable. This includes the continued management of the large-scale Ridge Road Stormwater Improvements Project, which is currently underway, as well as numerous future small-scale projects soon to come.
